**“CHRISTMAS BARK”**

This is a scrumptious dessert that was served during lunch at the November Quarterly Meeting and strongly urged to be shared with Friends through Quakerphernalia. Though this comes to you after Christmas, fortunately there are twelve days of Christmas and hopefully the newsletter has gotten to you in time...I'm sure it's good anytime of the year!!

1 sleeve of Saltines from a large box

1 cup butter

1/2 cup light brown sugar

1 package semi-sweet chocolate morsels

1 cup chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place crackers in one layer on a parchment lined baking sheet (with sides). Melt butter and brown sugar in small saucepan over medium heat. Cook for 3 minutes, stirring constantly. Pour butter-sugar mixture over the crackers, Spread evenly. Bake for 15 minutes. Remove from oven and sprinkle with choc. Morsels. When they start to melt, spread evenly over entire layer of crackers. Sprinkle chopped pecans on top. Refrigerate for an hour or longer . Crack into pieces and store in a covered tin.

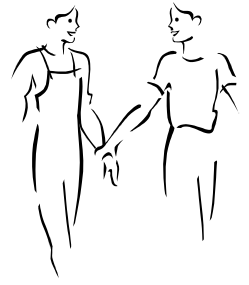
