48TH ANNUAL NAZARETH TO BETHLEHEM PEACE PILGRIMAGE

Walk the Road of Peace Saturday, December 8, **2007**. For over 40 years, during the Christmas season, people who believe in the importance of peace have been gathering to walk from Nazareth to Bethlehem (only ten miles in this country)! This pilgrimage, symbolic of the journey of Mary and Joseph, provides all of us, those who walk, those who pass us on the highway and even those who just read about the walk in the Sunday paper, with an opportunity to think about what Christmas really means. Come, walk with your family and friends, and make new friends who seek a more peaceful world. If you are concerned about your ability to complete the walk, please know that there are frequent rest stops and relief transportation.

It's more than a walk. Even if you cannot walk a portion of the pilgrimage, please consider participating in our related events. There will be traditional hymn signing in the heart of historic Bethlehem. Following singing, we'll walk a little farther to the Christ United Church of Christ for a simple supper. After supper, guest speaker, Alan Jennings, Executive Director of the Community Action Committee of the Lehigh Valley, will talk about, "Irresponsible Stewardship: Are We Too Polite?"






