WRIGHTSTOWN FRIENDS NURSERY SCHOOL AUCTION

On **April 26, 2008 at 6:00 PM**, Wrightstown Friends Nursery School will hold its twentieth annual auction. Friends are welcome to attend! Traditionally, the proceeds raised by this event have funded special needs, tuition assistance and various educational programs for our nursery school children. AN OLD GREEN BUILDING STORY

Charles Hough, long-time George School architect and member of Plymouth Monthly Meeting, will tell the story of how the 1812 Central Philadelphia Meetinghouse on 12th Street in Philadelphia, was moved to George School in 1973 to 1974. Charlie will present the fascinating photographic history on Wednesday, **April 23, 2008 at 7 p.m.** in the George School Meetinghouse. All are welcome. Learn how twentieth-century Quakers moved the eight sixty-foot hand-hewn roof trusses, exterior trim, thirty windows with shutters, benches and cushions, interior wainscoting, flooring, countless bricks (about 75 percent of the old bricks were salvaged, washed, and blended with new brick) and five doorways with doors, porches, and marble steps. The presentation documents how the tons of construction materials were moved and reassembled. The meetinghouse was the birthplace of the American Friends Service Committee and the headquarters of many local, national, and worldwide Quaker organizations.

NEW HOSPICE VOLUNTEER TRAINING

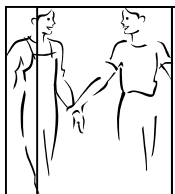

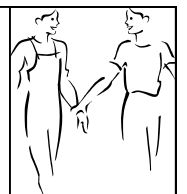
