A WORTHY LOCAL CAUSE FOR  
MEETINGS IN BUCKS QUARTER**

Audrey Tucker, the executive director of Family Service Association of Bucks County visited with Bristol Friends on March 1st. Bristol Friends have been supporting the shelter for a number of years as well as a couple of other meetings in the quarter. The agency opened in 1953 and also operates the homeless shelter and homeless hotline among its many services. They have reorganized since taking the shelter over from the Red Cross and now there is a single portal of entry to all the services they provide. Below is a list of needs the expressed during Audrey's visit.

Help with funding for people about to be released from the shelter into apartments.

There are also a host of miscellaneous needs for which there is no current available resource:

- Money for an apartment applications,
- uniforms for a new job
- expenses in obtaining a birth certificate, etc.

They are now providing budget counseling to the residents, and one half of their income must be saved during the time they reside in the shelter.
