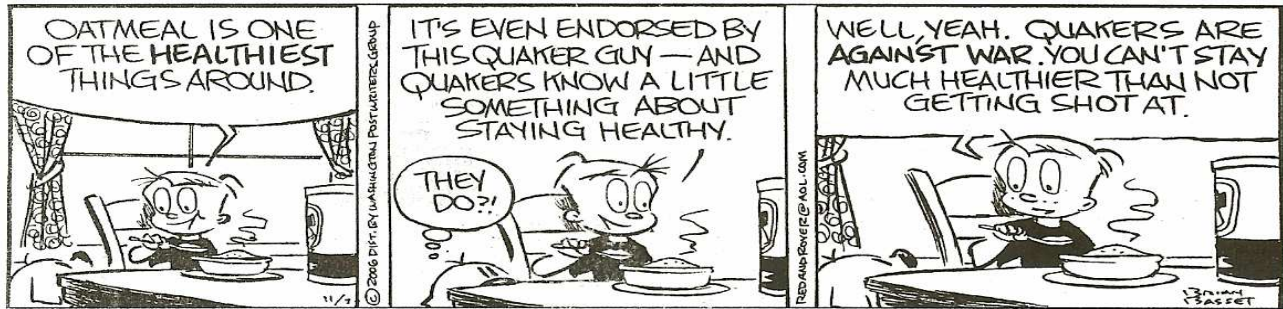
PEACE VIGIL REMINDER

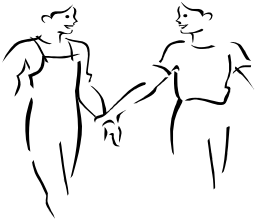

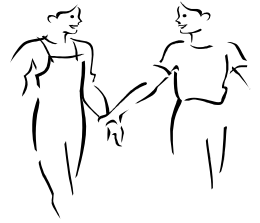
